...darker and scarier than *Goosebumps* and the first three Harry Potter books...

...comparable in content to *Harry Potter and the Goblet of Fire*...

...less violent than *Harry Potter and the Half Blood Prince*...

...extremely less provocative than any *Twilight* book or movie...

...darker and scarier than any Disney Pixar movie...

...extremely less violent, dark, and scary than most PG-13 movies such as *The Ring* or *Cloverfield*.

It is strongly suggested parents read the first chapter (the darkest chapter) and the twenty-sixth chapter (the most intense chapter) before approving this book for your young adult.
